

Copyright Licensing Agreement for songs written by Paul Hilts

Updated August 24, 2008

Thank you for requesting permission to reprint the music and/or lyrics of songs written by Paul Hilts. We appreciate your concern for copyrights! The livelihood of many musicians depends strongly on the revenue they earn from their music.

Annual Registration

This registration allows an organization to reprint, make transparencies, or display through an electronic projection system the music and/or lyrics of songs written by Paul Hilts for a period of one year. The registrant is allowed to produce an unlimited number of copies, provided that the copies are never sold or exchanged for the registrant's gain. The annual fees are as follows:

Prayer Group or Youth Group	\$20 per year
Parish or Church	\$50 per year

Single Event Registration

This registration allows an organization to reprint, make transparencies, or display through an electronic projection system the music and/or lyrics of songs written by Paul Hilts for a single event which may not exceed 10 consecutive days in any one year. The registrant is allowed to produce a chosen number of copies, provided that the copies are never sold or exchanged for the registrant's gain. If using transparencies or an electronic projection system, the fee is based on the number of expected viewers (that is, the expected attendance at the event). The single event fees are as follows:

Fewer than 1,000 copies or viewers	\$5 per song
1,000 or more copies or viewers	\$10 per song
